Instructions for publication of the proceedings

Manuscripts should be sent to Robert Laffineur at r.laffineur@ulg.ac.be by **30 June 2014** at the latest. Contributors are requested to comply with that date in order to meet the deadlines for issuing the volume in 2015. Only those papers/posters that have been presented at the conference (either in person or in absentia) will be included in the proceedings.

1. The text of papers must be submitted as a .doc file, limited to **8 pages** at *Aegaeum* standards (refer to a recent volume in the series for the number of signs on a page), with acknowledgements included in a * footnote at the end of the title. The list of illustrations, with full captions and copyright indications, has to be given on an additional page. Posters are limited to **3 pages**. Quotations in Greek and other foreign scripts have to be provided in Unicode fonts only. Texts in English by non native English speakers should be checked by a native English speaker before submission.

Bibliographical references should conform strictly to the *ars citandi* used in the *Aegaeum* series (see below). Authors are requested to avoid the Harvard quotation system (Betancourt 1992, 235). Manuscripts using that system will be returned to the authors for correction. Abbreviations for periodicals are those listed regularly in *Bulletin de Correspondance Hellénique* (http://www.persee.fr/web/revues/home/prescript/article/bch_0007-4217_1983_num_107_1_6442)

References which are frequently quoted will be abbreviated by the editors (*e.g. Sanctuaries and Cults* for the proceedings of the first Symposium at the Swedish Institute in Athens) and a list of those general abbreviations will appear at the beginning of the volume, as well as at the back of the cover sheet of the .pdf offprint.

2. Illustrations will be limited to unpublished or indispensable material. Photographs and line drawings must be provided as .jpg or .tif files, with the highest definition possible, and sent via Dropbox, WeTransfer or on a CD if necessary, as individual files (layouts with distribution of figures on full page plates are not accepted).
